On New Year's Eve Rendon Homes sold Villas de Las Misiones to COIL CDC, the Center on Independent Living Community Development Corporation. The apartment complex had been under contract for several months - during which time COIL CDC sought favorable financing to purchase the newly built complex.

Frost National Bank took on the underwriting of the project and approved the loan in December of 2004. Tony Rendon relinquished ownership of the ground breaking project (which he co-designed and developed with COLL), knowing the residents would be in good hands. COLL has been around since 1985 providing services and support to people with disabilities and the elderly.

The majority of housing developed by the COIL CDC will be affordable, accessible housing. A second project is under construction in the area of I-35 and Loop 410. An additional 20 units will be available around December of 2004, of which 10 will be fully accessible. Our third project is in predevelopment and is located on the eastside of San Antonio. A non-profit, volunteer board of directors heads the organization.
